

## Tri-Township Park District

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Tri-Township Park District was held in the Troy City Council Room on Monday Evening July 24, 1967

Bills and Claims: A bill for taking pictures of the Herman Hecht property for appraisal purposes, which was paid by Russell Wisemeyer, was presented. The amount being \$30<sup>00</sup>.
