

Tri-Township Park District - April 20 1970.

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Tri-Township Park District was held Monday Evening, April 20th, 1970 at the home of Russell Wiesemeyer.

Commissioners present were: Russell Wiesemeyer, Oscar Sindler, Milton Fangerwaller, George Schmalz and J. W. Dull.

Others present were: Attorney Wendell Durr, Ralph Peterson, from Troy School District, and Jim Bash, Les Buss, and Terry Roderick, all from the Troy Jaycees.

The meeting was called to order by president Wiesemeyer at 7:40 P.M. Mr Peterson was called upon. He requested information as to how the 7th grade students, and perhaps the 8th & 9th grade students, could assist in the Park development and as to how they might raise money for the Park. It seemed to be the opinion of the Board that any legitimate method of raising funds that did not involve gambling or liquor would not be frowned on by the Board. It was pointed out by Mr. Wiesemeyer that one method of raising money might be the sale of Home Coming Tickets for the Lion's club.

The Jaycees were then called upon. They were present to explore the possibility of them building a hall on the Park Property. It would probably be a concrete block Building with kitchen facilities of not less than 40' x 40' in size. The hall would be for public use, but the Jaycees would want a representative to have some authority in approving dates for organizations wishing to use the hall. Other problems that were discussed and would need to be worked out are:

1. Supplying fuel for heat and power for lights etc.
2. Maintenance of Bldg & Grounds.
3. Water and Sewer Bills.
4. Insurance on



Our 1970 appropriation and tax levy was briefly discussed. Due to Wendell Durr being in Springfield on the Con Con Convention on our regular meeting night in April, J.W. Dull moved, seconded by Oscar Sindler and carried, that we hold our April meeting at Russell Wiesemeyer's Home on April 20, 1970 at 7:30 P.M.

Bids and contracts on Park work was discussed. J.W. Dull is to check with G.A. Shaffer on Insurance to cover possible accidents on people working on Park Projects.

The Treasurer's Report for March 23 was read. It was moved by Oscar Sindler, seconded by Milton Langenwaller and carried, that the Treasurer's report be accepted as read.

Note: a special meeting was held at Russell Wiesemeyer's Home on Monday Evening, March 2, 1970 at 7:00 P.M. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the possibility of various organizations taking the responsibility of organizing and developing various Park Projects.

It was moved by Milton Langenwaller, seconded by Oscar Sindler and carried that the meeting be adjourned. President Wiesemeyer declared the meeting adjourned at 10:00 P.M.
