

Tri-Township Park District
March 5 1973.

A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Tri-Township Park District was held Monday Evening March 5, 1973 at Russ's Car Wash.

Commissioners present were: Russell Wiesemeyer, Oscar Lindler, Milton Langenwaller, and J. W. Dull

Others present were: Don Walsh, Albert Arth, and Bill Thompson.

President Wiesemeyer called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

Don Walsh of Miracle Recreation and Equipment Company was called upon. He discussed park equipment to considerable extent, principally Shelters and picnic tables. It was Don Walsh's opinion that we could circumvent a 5% increase in prices proposed for April 1, 1973, if we had a call for bids before that time. It was agreed to have Mr. Walsh write up a bid form together with specifications for Shelters, Picnic Tables, and Barbeque Pits to send to several companies, with bids to be opened at our regular meeting on March 26, 1973.

Mr. Thompson reported on studies he had made on the old House. He said that the house could be re-habilitated for a private residence, but that he would not recommend trying to rebuild it to standards required for a public building with a library, reading rooms, etc.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 P.M.
