The regular monthly meeting of the Tri-Township rark District Board of Commissioners was convened at 7:30 F.M.. Attorney Caditan crepared the necessary paperwork for channeling the tax receipts to the Troy Security Bank in payment of the anticipate loar which will be required to complete the tennis courts. Commissione wiesemeyer and Jommissioner Leonard have signed these documents and a affixed the official seal, subject to approval of all other Commissioners.

Commissioner wiesemeyer suggested that some thought be given to tennis court scheduling. Commissioner Langenwalter agreed to inquire into the manner of scheduling used by the Collinsville District.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 F.M. was made by Commissioner findler, seconded by Commissioner fargenwalter and carried.
