

MINUTES - TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT

The regular monthly meeting of the Tri-Township Park District Board of Commissioners was convened at 7:55 P.M. on December 21, 1978, at the pavillion meeting room with president Russell Wiesemeyer presiding. Commissioners answering present to the roll call were Commissioners Albert Arth, Milton Langenwalter, Leland Leonard and Russell Wiesemeyer.

Motion to adjourn meeting at 9:30 was made by Commissioner Leonard, seconded by Commissioner Arth and carried.
