

The regular monthly meeting of the Tri Township
Parks District Board of Commissioners was convened at the
^{Spring Township}
Sr. Citizens Center at 7:30 P.M. on November 20, 1985 with
president Russell Husinger presiding. In addition to the
president Commissioners answering present to the roll call
were, Couch, Sartorius & Jarman. Also present were
Attorney Codrigan, Edgar Long, Khway League & John Helf,
American Legion.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read &
approved.

The treasurer's report was read & the bills were read.
Motion to accept same & pay bills was made by Com
Jarman, seconded by Com Couch & carried.

Com Jarman suggested that gravel be purchased for
the east end of the lake. Troy Ruddy Mix gave an estimate
of \$1500.00. Jarman also suggested that it might be better to
lay plastic first and top with rocks, and to install a
concrete curb. Com Husinger suggested that other estimates
be obtained. Com Sartorius agreed to talk with Don Swoboda
& Com Husinger will get in touch with Groffhane about
it.

Mr. Somanis found that the park truck did not need
a new starter but some repair will be required on the shift
indicator.

Letter to the Board was read from Bernice Arth,
widow of former Com. Arth.

Attorney Codrigan explained that the question of duplicate
insurance coverage by the District & the organizations participating
in sports in the Park cannot be avoided because the
groups are active at other locations than the Park.

Attorney Cadogan reviewed the Hockey League & Soccer Club policies and advised that no changes be made.

The Soccer Club concession stand will be moved into the Park on November 29.

Com Jarman advised that trenches are developing over the newly installed water lines. There is excess dirt from the Ball Diamond preparation but dirt moving equipment will be needed. The Board agreed to have Com Thiesmeyer engage Hestfall or Suter for the job.

Com Jarman also advised that there are various pieces of useless equipment in the storage shed. The Board agreed that it should be salvaged.

Motion was made by Com Foucek, 2nd by Com Gantner & carried to begin charging a \$10.00 cleanup deposit in addition to the regular \$25.00 fee in 1986. Jasper Pundleton or Andrew Semanick will check for accomplishment of cleanup. If the inspection is favorable the deposit will be refunded. A list will be provided the treasurer once a month on meeting night for refund of deposits.

Motion was made by Com Jarman, seconded by Com Gantner & carried that Attorney Cadogan should proceed with a suit against Daniel Rollberg for one month unpaid rent on the trashes.
