

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Township Park District was convened at the St. Citizen Building at 7:30 P.M. on April 19, 1986 with the president Russell Krummiger presiding. In addition to the president Commissioners answering present to the roll call were Com. Gantner, Greenfield & Jarman.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read & approved.

The treasurer's report was read. Motion to accept was made by Com. Greenfield, seconded by Com. Jarman & carried. The bills were presented. Motion to accept and pay made by Com. Gantner, second by Com. Jarman & carried.

Vandalism damage to storage building doors was turned in to MCF Commercial Service but no reply has been received.

As of date of meeting no ^{response} reply has been received from gamester on delivery of the recreation equipment.

Com. Greenfield will supervise the installation of the bleachers with the help of soccer & Khoney League.

Senamian reported that a good job was done by the Boy Scout Troop in cleaning the lake of debris.

Com. Greenfield was unable to contact Westfall for tapping into the water line & filling in trenches resulting from installation of the drinking fountain so he tapped into the water line for the new concession stand himself. Com. Krummiger will inquire if Senamian & Smeyers can fill in the trenches. Otherwise he will try to get Westfall.

The weather has not permitted the sandblasting control

Motion was made by ^{Com} Greenfield, seconded by Com Frank & carried to transfer \$2000. from the N. Hunt Account to checking.

Com Kuesmeyer reported that the Budget & Appropriation has been posted at the City Hall.

Com Kuesmeyer reported that Allan Dunston relayed to him that Mayor Cibley is ready to talk about donating the right of access road to the City so the City can apply for Community Development funds. The Board agreed to Com Kuesmeyer's suggestion that a rider be attached to the transfer that roadway will be completed within a reasonable length of time. Com Kuesmeyer will ask Attorney Codignin to go ahead with the transfer.

Com Greenfield will write letters to the City & the Township requesting assistance thru Revenue Sharing on the fence fund in the amount of \$5,000 each. Com Kuesmeyer suggested that all Park Board members attend the hearing on distribution of Revenue Sharing monies. Com Greenfield said that R. S. might be applied in regard.

The Board agreed that a letter of thanks should be sent to the shoppers for their donation to the fence fund. Com Greenfield will draft a letter to the taxpayers for contributions to the fence fund.

Com Kuesmeyer will compare Lewis Tencing bid received by Com Jarman with Anthony's bid. It is expected that the area to be fenced - north, east & west sides will cost approximately \$35,000 at 1.90 per ft. ^{for material only} for 7 ft. fence. Frances Mills reported that the ball diamond
