

ORDINANCE NO. 1979-1

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IN TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK, CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Tri-Township Park District has determined that the possession of alcoholic liquor in Tri-Township Park endangers the public health, morals and public welfare;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT, CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that it is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to possess any alcoholic liquor within Tri-Township Park, City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois unless he shall have first obtained a permit therefor issued by Tri-Township Park District. Application for a permit must be received by the District at least seven (7) days prior to its effective date.


Any person convicted of violation of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$500.00.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication according to law.

PASSED by the Board of Commissioners of Tri-Township Park District, City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, by a roll call vote in regular meeting, a majority of the corporate authorities voting in favor of said Ordinance, approved by the President of said Board and attested by the Clerk of said Board, and deposited in the Office of the Clerk of the Tri- Township Park District, City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, this 15th day of May, 1979.




Any person convicted of violation of this Ordinance shall

PARK DISTRICT BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR 1979-80
of the Tri-Township Park District in the County of Madison,
State of Illinois, for the Fiscal Year beginning April 1,
1979 and ending March 31, 1980.

WHEREAS, all legal requirements have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Board of Commissioners
of the Tri-Township Park District, Madison County, Illinois, in
meeting assembled, as follows:

ARTICLE I

That the fiscal year of this Park District is hereby fixed
and declared to be from April 1, 1979 to March 31, 1980.

ARTICLE II

That the following budget, containing a statement of the
cash on hand at the beginning of the fiscal year, an estimate of
the cash expected to be received during said fiscal year, an es-
timate of the expenditures contemplated for such fiscal year and
a statement of the estimated cash expected to be on hand at the
end of such fiscal year is hereby adopted as the budget of this
Park District for the said fiscal year and shall be in full force
and effect from and after said date.

ARTICLE IV

That all unexpended balances of any item or items of any general appropriation made in this Ordinance, be expended in making up any insufficiency in any other item or items in the same general appropriation for the same general purpose of any like appropriation made by this Ordinance.

ARTICLE V

That all unexpended balances from annual appropriation of previous years are hereby re-appropriated.


ARTICLE VI
