#### **GENERAL FAQ**

# What time is camp? Is there before and after care?

Camp runs from 9AM until 5PM. If you need to drop off earlier or pick up later, you can add before care from 7-9AM or after care from 5-6PM.

### What does a day at camp look like?

Busy! Most camp days include four structured activities, a skate session, a large group game, and scheduled free time. Free time is directly after lunch and options include playing on the playground, working on crafts/reading or going on a walk to earn points for our walking club.

Before and after care times are more relaxed than our 9-5 camp structure and usually include sports, crafts, and playground time.

# What do campers need to bring each day?

We ask that campers bring a water bottle, lunch, snack, and tennis shoes/socks daily. A backpack to carry all their items is highly suggested!

#### Staff to camper ratio

1:10 - this does not include our head staff who move from group to group throughout the day.

# The week I wanted to send my child(ren) is full - now what?

Please call the office or go online to add your name to the waitlist. If a child drops from that week, we will go down the waitlist to fill in those empty spots.

#### Can my child(ren) be in the same group as their friend(s)?

We will try! We do our best to group friends together, but occasionally the amount of requests can make it difficult to make all of those requests happen. Three day and five day campers are not likely to be grouped together.

#### Can I sign up for 3 days one week and 5 days another week?

Yes, just let us know when you are registering or if registering online, choose the option you prefer.

### What days are included in the 3 day option?

The 3 day option is set as Monday, Wednesday, Friday but if you need different days just let us know by the Wednesday before that week.

# How much does camp cost? (Resident/Non-Resident)

5 Days: \$105/\$120 3 Days: \$90/\$105

4 Days (5/31 & 7/5 weeks only): \$90/\$105

Before Care: \$12/week After Care: \$10/week

#### How do I know if I'm a resident?

If you pay taxes to the Tri-Township Park District or Triad School District we consider you can receive resident pricing. If the wrong price is showing up on your online account, give us a call at 618-667-6887.

#### We're going on vacation! Can I get a refund?

Yes, we do full refunds as long as we are notified by 5PM the Wednesday before the week you would like a refund. This is also applicable if changing from 5 to 3 days or removing before/after care. If we are notified after 4PM the Wednesday before the week in question, we will not process a refund.

# How do payments work?

Payment in full is required to register. If registering far enough in advance, payment plans can be created with payment in full still being due before camp begins. Email <a href="mailto:marissa@tritownshippark.org">marissa@tritownshippark.org</a> with more questions about payment plans.

### I have multiple kids attending, is there a discount?

Third child attending is 20% off, fourth child is 30% off. Must live in the same household and discount only applies to weeks they are all attending. To receive this discount, you must register over the phone or in person.

#### **COUNSELORS IN TRAINING**

#### How do I register my child for the CIT program?

They will need to fill out the application from our website and turn it in by April 1st. After that, applicants will be considered and possibly interviewed. All applicants will be chosen and contacted by the end of April.

# Does my child need to have attended camp before to be a CIT?

Not necessarily. Past campers are given priority, but new applicants will be considered!

# Do CITs need to attend 5 days or can they attend 3 days for the weeks they are registered?

Because CITs have program goals and are assigned counselors to help, we ask that they attend 5 days both weeks of the session they have applied for and been accepted to.

# How much does the CIT program cost?

The CIT program is \$105 per session.

What sessions are available for CITs? How many sessions can my child apply for?

CITs can apply for as few or as many sessions as they wish. The amount of sessions applied for will not affect which applicants are chosen.

Session 1: May 31st - June 3rd, June 6th- June 10th

Session 2: June 13th - June 17th, June 20th- June 24th

Session 3: June 27th - July 1st, July 5th - July 8th

Session 4: July 11th - July 15th, July 18th - July 22nd

Session 5: July 25th - July 29th, August 1st - August 5th
