The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Tri-Township Park District was held Monday Evening at Russ's Car Wash, July 24 1972.

Commissioners present were: Oscar Sindler, Milton Langenwalter, George Schmalz, & J. W. Dull.

The meeting was called to order by Vice-President Oscar Sindler at 8:00 P.M.

The Minutes of the previous meeting of June 26 1972 were read and approved as corrected. The correction being that the tax levy Ordinance No. 1972-2 was from April 1-1972 until March 31, 1973 instead of April 1-1972 until May 31, 1972 as shown.
