

Tri-Township Park District
October 23 1972.

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Tri-Township Park District held their regular meeting on Monday Evening, October 23 1972, at Russ's Car Wash.

Commissioners present were: Russell Wiesemeyer, Oscar Lindler, Milton Langerwalter, and J.W. Dull.

Others present were: Wm. R. Thompson.

Present Wiesemeyer called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M.

The minutes of the previous meeting of Sept. 25 1972 were read and approved as read.

Reports of Officers: Russell Wiesemeyer reported that he had called Bob Cook about the flower garden at the Park. He also called Mr. Segelhorst. Russell Wiesemeyer also reported he had called the Southwestern Illinois Metropolitan Area Planning Commission and was told we could not get matching funds for rebuilding the house on the Park.

Oscar Lindler reported that he had been advised not to try to remove cat tails from the lake with a back-hoe, because it would destroy too many fish. They should be pulled by hand, if possible, and then sprayed with a herbicide next spring. Oscar Lindler also reported that all footings for the Pavilion floor were dug and about half of the floor

the cat-tails by back-hoe methods. The motion was seconded by George Schmalz and carried. Oscar Lindler thought that maybe a couple of men could pull the cat-tails and throw them out on the bank cheaper. This will be looked into.

The Treasurer's report was read. It was moved by Oscar Lindler, and seconded by Milton Langerwaller, that the Treasurer's Report be accepted. The motion carried.
