Change made on the appropriation ordinance, Insurance increased to \$2000.00 (Section 1), Section # part A - #1 Labor and equipment rental increased to \$20,000.00 #2 Materials increased to \$30,000.00

Motion made by Milton Langmwater to charge \$10.00 in advance for clean up to parties reserving large pavilion, money refunded if cleaned up satisfactory by party reserving pavilion.

Second by Leland Leonard.

Motion carried.

Motion made by Leland Leonard to adjourn, second by Albert Arth. Motion carried Meeting adjourned at 10:30 p.m.
