MINUTES - TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT

The regular monthly meeting of the Tri-Township Park District Board of Commissioners was convened at the park trailer on November 16, 1982 with president Russell Wiesemeyer presiding. In addition to the president, Commissioners answering present to the roll call were Foucek and Leonard.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Chief Quinley replied on the vandalism to the ball diamond which occurred three years ago. He said the judge pronounced it a misdemeanor and released the person on a recognisance bond. Commissioner Leonard reported that an arrest was made recently after a person was apprehended driving off the road making deep ruts in the rain soaked grounds. Tom Recklein took pictures of the damage. Meyer yard service estimated the damage at \$275.00. The pictures and the estimate were filed with the police department.

The Treasurer's report was read and the bills were presented. Motion to accept treasurer's report and pay bills was made by Commissioner Foucek, seconded by Commissioner Leonard and carried.

In reply to Commissioner Wiesemeyer's question on amount of taxes collected so far, the amount was determined to be \$24,420.87.

Commissioner Wiesemeyer discussed the lighting conditions on the parking lot. He requested permission from the Board to ask Mayor Criley to inspect the street side of the parking lot for the approval of two more street lights in front of it. The Board agreed.

The Fire Department flushed out the drain in the lake. Commissioner Wiesemeyer requested a letter of appreciation be sent.

Commissioner Wiesemeyer will call Mrs. Ebetsch, Community Development, for information on the land grant before the next meeting, since the Lions's Club may need their money.

The applications for watchman were reviewed and one applicant was accepted. Commissioner Wiesemeyer will follow through on notifying the individual.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
